2 Financial Statement of Q1 2014-15

This quarter we have spent Rs. 6,16,567 of which 91% was spent towards fees and 5% towards providing Bus pass to the students and around 2% on Lunch for students on Sundays and remaining 2% on other Miscellineous expenses.

We have received donations of Rs. 4.76 lakhs and our balance at the end of the quarter is Rs. 1.23 lakhs.




Figure 1: Expense Breakup

The breakup of total expenses is graphically illustrated in Figure 1
