1 Update of 2014-15 Quarter 2

The quarter started with last minute admissions and soon got into the regular session cycle. Focus was given to make the new students comfortable in the new environment and also to help our graduated students with placements.

This has been a happening quarter with lot of activities which included Annual Day, Quiz, Logo competition, presentation on Health and Hygiene and Mock Interview.

1.1 FoCh celebrated its 14th Annual Day

The 14th annual day was celebrated on 14th of September, 2014 at Udaya Bhanu Kala Sangha. Like last year, this year too the annual day was organized and coordinated completely by our students. Our students showcased their talents - dancing, acting, singing and presentation skills. Veena of 3rd B.Com created a video invitation for the event, we appreciate her innovative idea.



The annual day celebration started with invocation song followed by group dances, solo dances, comedy skit and a skit on child marriage. A mime by 2nd B.Com students saying "*No to female infanticide*" was the highlight of the day. Another first was a fashion show. Our girls dressed up in ethnic dresses of different regions of India and came up with a catchy line from the region to make the audience guess the region. All the graduated students and students who completed 2nd PUC were felicitated. The winners and the runners up of the Annual Quiz were awarded prizes. The annual report was presented by Santosh and Kalaivani. Over all this year's annual day celebration was thoroughly enjoyed by our audience. The event is getting

1.2 Launching of new Logo

We wanted to design a logo, and thought that the best can come from our students itself. We conducted a logo competition for all the students and received an encouraging response. About 25 logos designs were received. A team of 5 volunteers evaluated the entries and selected a logo created by Jhancy, 3rd B.Com. The logo will undergo necessary modifications before being launched.

1.3 Annual Ouiz

As usual the quiz consisted of a written qualifying round, followed by the final oral quiz. This year we the written quiz was created and conducted by our post graduate students Rajesh, M.Sc 2nd year and Kiran, M.Com, 2nd year. The quiz was open for all PUC and under graduate students. In total 60 students appeared for the written round, out of which 8 students (4 teams of 2 students each) were selected for the final round.

The team of Ramya, 1st PUC and Sowmya, 3rd B.Com won the 1st place in the finals.

1.4 Mock Interview

Mock interview was conducted for 2^{nd} year and 3^{rd} year degree students, to help them experience job interviews. Students were screened through Aptitude and English tests followed by a group discussion. Selected students had to undergo multiple rounds of interviews. Help was taken from our alumni for conducting technical interviews. Based on the performance of students in the various rounds, finally 2 students Veena, 3^{rd} B.Com and Pavan, 3^{rd} B.Com were selected.

All students were given individual feedback, and it also gave us insight on preparedness of students to face the interviews. We have identified activities accordingly to bridge the gaps.

1.5 Presentation on Health and Hygiene by Medical College students

Students of final year medicine from JJM Medical College, Davangere gave a talk on Health and Hygiene to our students. The talk covered aspects of health and hygiene including personal hygiene and cleanliness, types of diseases, causes and impact. Importance of balanced diet and effects of unbalanced diet on the health of a person was also covered. It was well received by the students and they asked many questions, and it turned out to be a very interactive session.

1.6 Examination and Results

The Even Semester examination results were declared. 8 students had appeared for B.Com 2nd semester exams, 11 students for B.Com 4th semester, and 16 students for B.Com 6th Semester. Out of the 16 students appearing for B.Com 6th semester, **15 completed their graduation successfully**. Unfortunately one student has an arrear in one subject which she can clear in June 2015. The details of results are given below in Table 1.

2 Financial Statement of Q2 2014-15

This quarter we have spent Rs. 184,024 of which 39% was spent towards fees, 32% towards Bus passes, around 11% on Lunch for students on Sundays, 8% on Books, 7% on prizes for graduate students and rest 3% on other Miscellineous expenses.

We have received donations to the tune of Rs. 2.44 lakhs and our balance at the end of the quarter is Rs. 1.84 lakhs.




Figure 1: Expense Breakup

The breakup of total expenses is graphically illustrated in Figure 1
