# Operational Process



## Identification & Selection

- Students identified from various sources like Schools, Alumni, Donors, Current students and Prerana.
- Selection process involves
  - One-One discussion with the students to understand their needs and interests
  - House visit to gauge the situation at home and financial capabilities of the family
  - Assessment to understand the strengths of student and to decide appropriate stream
  - Extra-curricular activities to make them comfortable in new environment
  - Student and Parent agreement form need to be signed before any support

# Operational Process



## Support:

- Full support
  - All expenses like fee, books, bus pass and additional courses
- Partial support
- Health aid

## Mentoring:

- Weekend sessions at Bhavan Bangalore Press School which involves
  - Academic guidance
  - Personality development
    - Improve communications by conducting activities like pick & speak, presentation from the students etc.
  - Aptitude classes, GD, Mock Placements
- Regular one-one discussion with the students
- Meeting the parents at least yearly once

# Highlights

- 9 students graduated – 8 students are placed
- 6 students(100%) passed in II PUC
- Good Volunteer to Student ratio
- External Panel Members and Alumni support in Mock placements
- Three alumni students pursuing PhD
- Regular Quarterly email updates to Donors & Well-wishers
- **Events**
  - Fresher's day & Parent's meeting
  - Monthly Birthday celebrations, One day outing to Nandi Hills
  - Seminars on Positive Attitude, Astronomy, Soft Skill, CV Preparations, etc

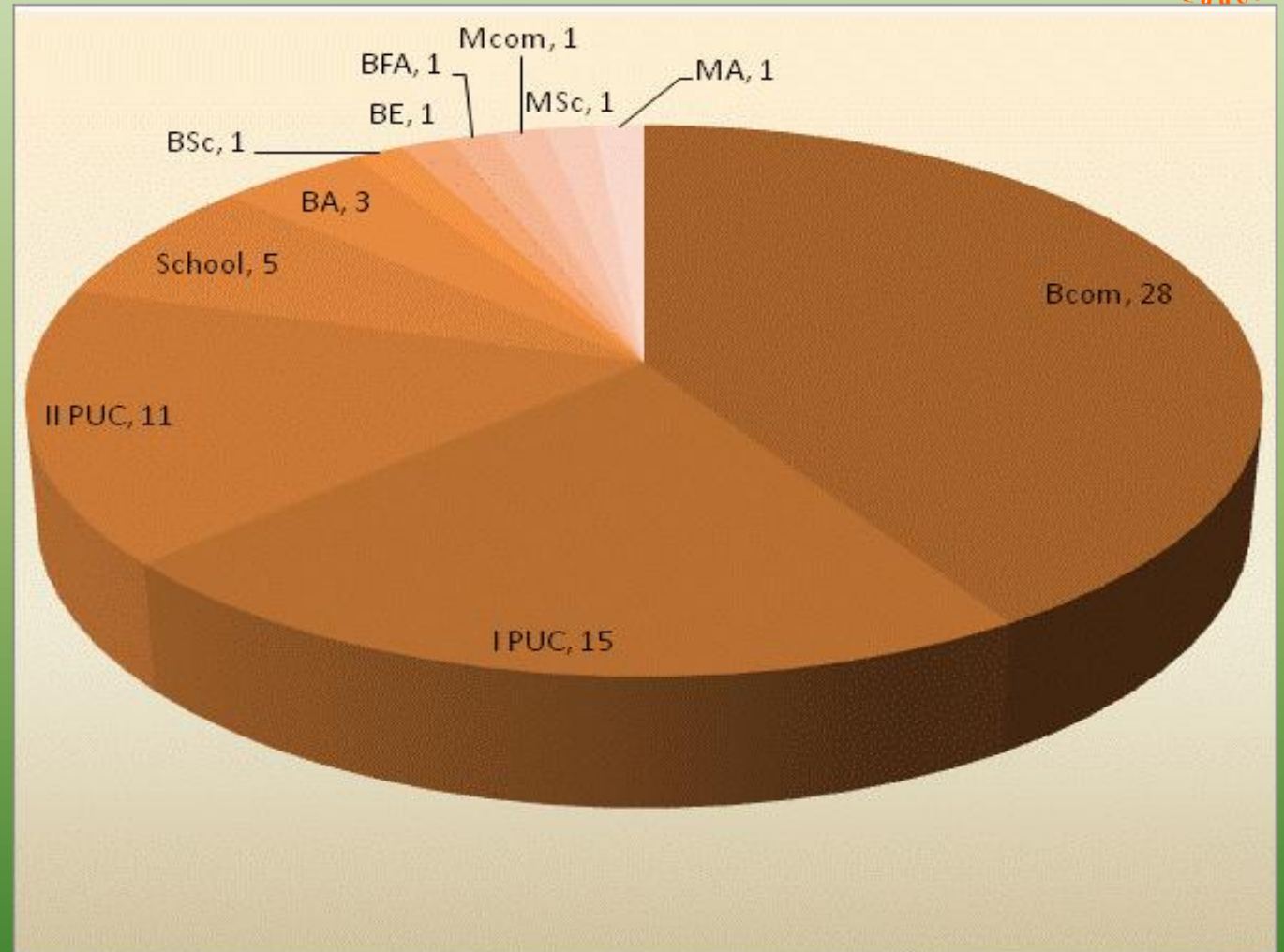

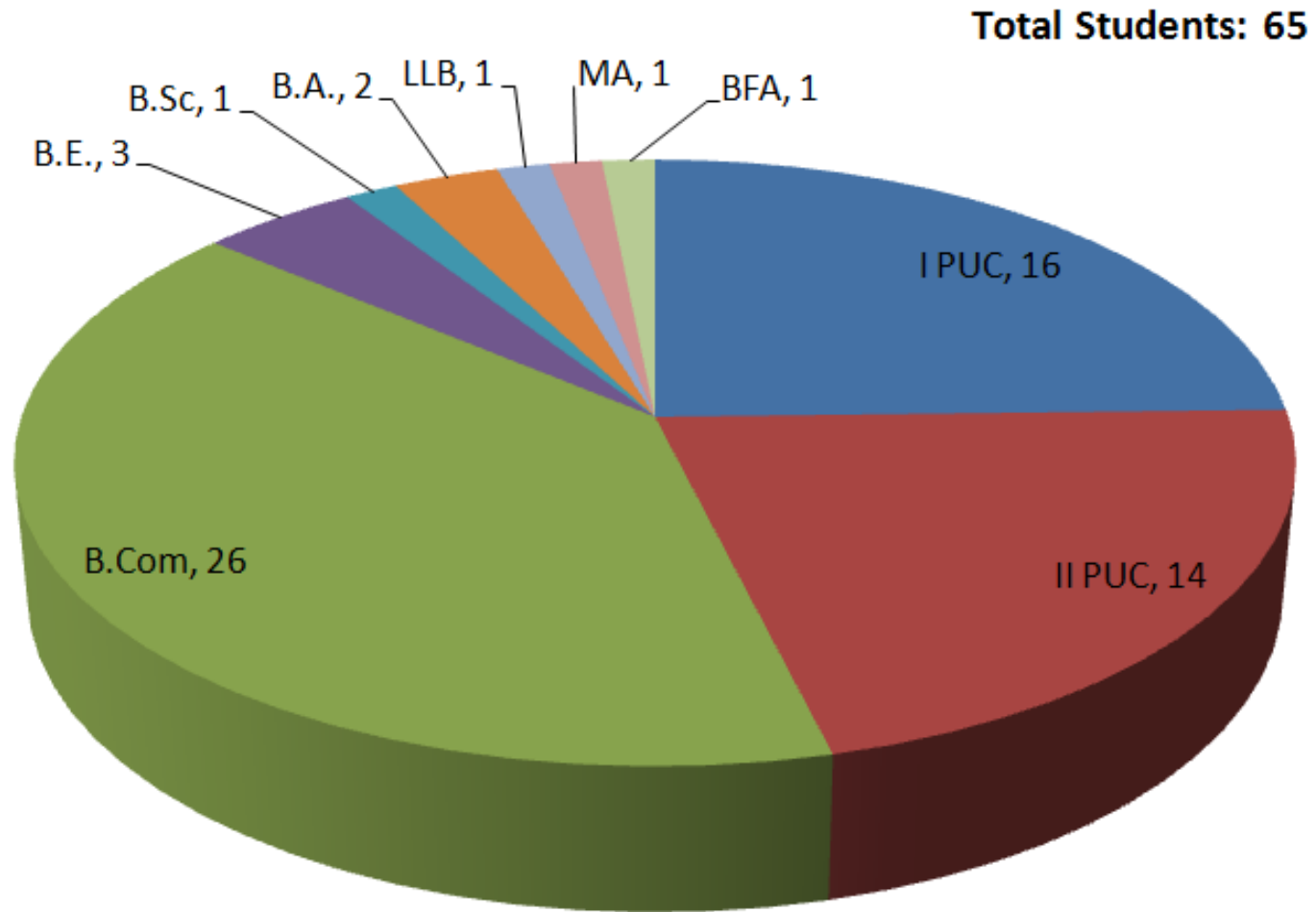

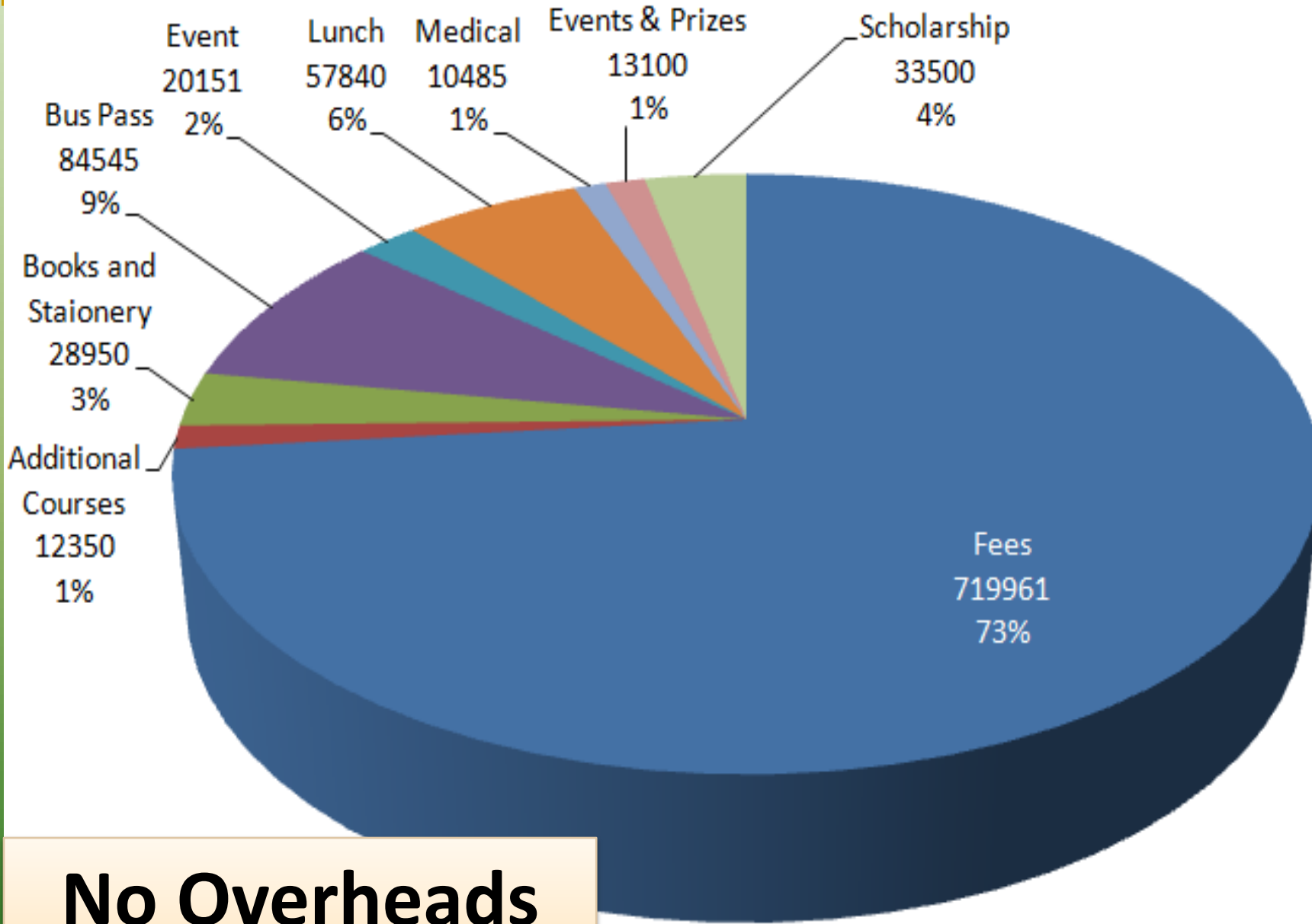
